CHS RELIGIOUS GOODS SHOP ANNEX AT ST. ANDREW'S

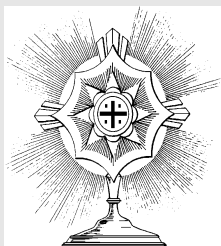
