### **YOUNG IN SPIRIT**

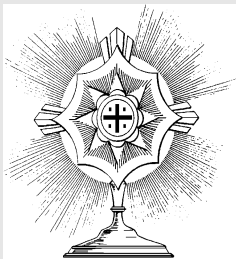
